Dear competitors,

The 19th Internet contest, the keyboarding competition via Internet, is now open and available 7/24.

Important news: we thank Helena Zaviačičová (ZAV) and Marco Olivo (Taki) for their collaboration to offer the result list in real time for both software.

Other implementations

- The registration time has been increased and overlaps the contest period.
- Till the end of the contest, teachers are able to write off the wrong registrations.
- Additional tools enable the teachers to carefully follow (with their personal access codes) the competition of their students to know who hasn't taken any test, who has forgotten to compete in their mother language.
- Payment is requested just at the end of the contest, so teachers can check the participation of their students, write off the ones who haven't taken the test and pay the correct amount.

Important recalls

1. It is important to carefully **check the spelling** of your students' names: what you write will be used for the automatic certificates. If you make a mistake, please delete the registration and do a new one. Please also write the given name first and then the family name.
2. The software allows you a **max of 40 characters** for the school name: please write it in the shortest form.
3. **No word in full capital letters:** only a capital letter at the first characters of proper nouns both for the competitor and the school names.
4. The **mother language is compulsory:** if a competitor wants to compete in a language which is not his/her native language, or in the mother language of the country where he/she is living, please indicate this language as mother tongue. A competitor not competing in his/her mother language doesn't appear in the mother classification list. You see his/her name in red in your students list.
5. To be classified and to receive a multilingual certificate, the competitor must be successful in at least 2 languages.
6. The exceptionally low **participation fee** hasn't change since the beginning of the contest, so for 19 years: **5 €** for competition in mother language, and **7 €** for the multilingual competition.

In these pandemic times, with a lot of perturbation in the students' life, we assume that the teachers know the abilities of their students and that online tools have been developed for video teaching, so they are also able to check their student's work even if they are not physically in the same classroom to do the test.

If you want to compete but are not a student or a member of a typing association, please write to the country delegate of your country. If there is no delegate in your country, please write to the jury president.
