Astrid Lulling (PPE). - Madame la Présidente, j'avoue avoir du mal à suivre mes collègues qui aiment tant montrer leurs muscles et se prévaloir du monopole de notre légitimité face aux autres institutions de l'Union. Malheureusement, leur posture est souvent dérisoire. Mais lorsque les membres de cette maison, à force de travail et de conviction, affirment une position argumentée lorsque nous défendons ce qui ressemble à un intérêt général européen face à des États crispés, la situation change du tout au tout.

Dans ce débat sur la supervision européenne, le Parlement a joué ce rôle. Au sujet du Comité européen du risque systémique, pour lequel je suis le rapporteur fictif de mon groupe, j'ai défendu, comme la rapporteure, Mme Goulard, une ligne ambitieuse. J'ai prôné des mécanismes assurant une certaine efficacité et j'ai insisté sur la prééminence de la Banque centrale européenne. Pourquoi? Parce que la Banque centrale européenne est bien la seule institution communautaire dans cet ensemble, et parce qu'elle a fait preuve de sérieux.

Par charité chrétienne, je tairai les noms de toutes les institutions et de tous ces grands personnages qui ont subitement disparu pendant la tempête. Nous pouvons nous déclarer heureux d'avoir eu, au moins, un capitaine à bord au plus fort de la crise. Je serais donc rassurée de voir demain la surveillance macroprudentielle adossée à une institution communautaire forte, alors que la surveillance microprudentielle restera forcément morcelée.

En ces temps troublés, le Comité européen du risque systémique doit se mettre au travail le plus vite possible. L'avenir montrera si des aménagements seront nécessaires, mais il est essentiel de partir sur des bases saines car les risques systémiques affectent l'ensemble du secteur bancaire européen et mondial.

THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 50, Article 53(1) and Articles 62 and 114 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the European Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee⁽³⁾,Having regard to the opinion of the European Central Bank⁽⁴⁾,Acting in accordance with the ordinary legislative procedure⁽⁵⁾,

Whereas:

(1) The financial crisis in 2007/2008 exposed important shortcomings in financial supervision, both in particular cases and in relation to the financial system as a whole. *Nationally based* supervisory models have lagged behind the integrated and interconnected reality of European financial markets, in which many financial firms operate across borders. The crisis exposed shortcomings in the area of cooperation, coordination, consistent application of *Union* law and trust between national supervisors.

(1a) The European Parliament has called regularly for the reinforcement of a more level playing-field for all actors at the Union level while pointing out failures in the Union's supervision of ever more integrated financial markets.

(2) A report published on 25 February 2009 by a high-level group of experts chaired by *Jacques de Larosière (the de Larosière Report)*, requested by the Commission, concluded that the supervisory framework *should* be strengthened to reduce the risk and severity of future financial crises.
